Dear Parents,

Students in our classrooms have severe allergies to the following foods:

Peanuts
Tree Nuts
Sesame

Exposure to these allergens could cause a life-threatening reaction. Our goal is to ensure that every student in our school is safe. We need your help to provide the safest school environment for these children.

To help provide a safe classroom:

- Foods containing these allergens are not allowed in this classroom.
- Remind your child not to offer, share or exchange food with other students at school.
- Eating is not allowed on buses.
- Do not send containers that have contained these allergens, such as washed out peanut butter jars to school.
- It is important that residue of these allergens are not on a child's hands when they handle common school books and equipment. Hand washing is an important control in preventing accidental exposure to these allergens. Remind your child to wash their hands after eating, especially if they have eaten foods containing these allergens.

Remember that these food guidelines apply to the classroom foods ONLY. Your child may continue to have these foods or products made with these foods in their lunch.
